The Future of Post-Human Culinary Art Feb 08 2021 Is culinary art really so exact that, as Delia Smith once wrote, "cooking is an exact art and not some casual game"? (BQ 2012) This exact view of cooking can be contrasted with an opposing observation by Tom Jaine, when he argued that, "if cooking becomes an art form rather than a means of providing a reasonable diet, then something is clearly wrong." (BQ 2012a) Contrary to these opposing views (and other ones as will be discussed in the book), culinary art, in relation to both ingredients and techniques, is neither possible or impossible, nor desirable or undesirable, to the extent that the respective ideologues on different sides would like us to believe.
